The services to be provided will include:

- 1. Master Plan.
- 2. Road construction engineering.
- 3. Geotechnical Engineering.
- 4. Utilities (water, electric and sewer)
- 5. Erosion control
- 6. 3-4 bedroom units
- 7. Preparing the construction bid package in conformance with applicable requirements.
- 8. Final Plat and documents for Seminole County.

Responses should include:

- 1. The firm's legal name, address and telephone number.
- 2. The principals of the firm and their experience and qualifications.
- 3. The experience and qualifications of the staff to be assigned to project.
- 4. A description of the firm's prior experience, including any similar projects (in particular those funded by HUD or another federal program), who has knowledge of the firms performance.
- 5. A description of the firm's current work activities and how these would be coordinated

with the project, as well as the firm's anticipated availability during the term of the project.

- a. include an approximation of the number of hours, the related costs to perform the services and the applicable hourly rate or multiplier for the base rate of individuals employed o the project.
- 6. Complete overall Cost Estimate

Maximum total of 100 points. The evaluation criteria to be used by the selection committee for the RFP are as follows:

- A. Overall Quality of the Proposal 20 points
- B. Staff Qualifications and Experience 15 points
- C. Previous construction design 15 points
- D. Availability 10 points
- E. Appropriateness of proposed timeline 10 points
- F. Evidence of understanding scope of work, site and existing conditions 10 points
- G. Indian Owned 10 points
- H. Cost Effectiveness 10 points

The selection of finalists to be interviewed will be based on an evaluation of the written responses. The award will be made to the most qualified offeror whose proposal is deemed most advantageous to the Housing Authority of the Seminole Nation, all factors considered. Unsuccessful offerors will be notified as soon as possible.
